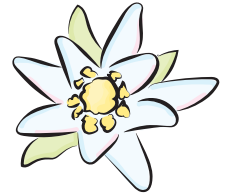

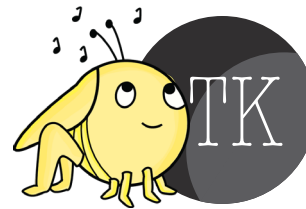

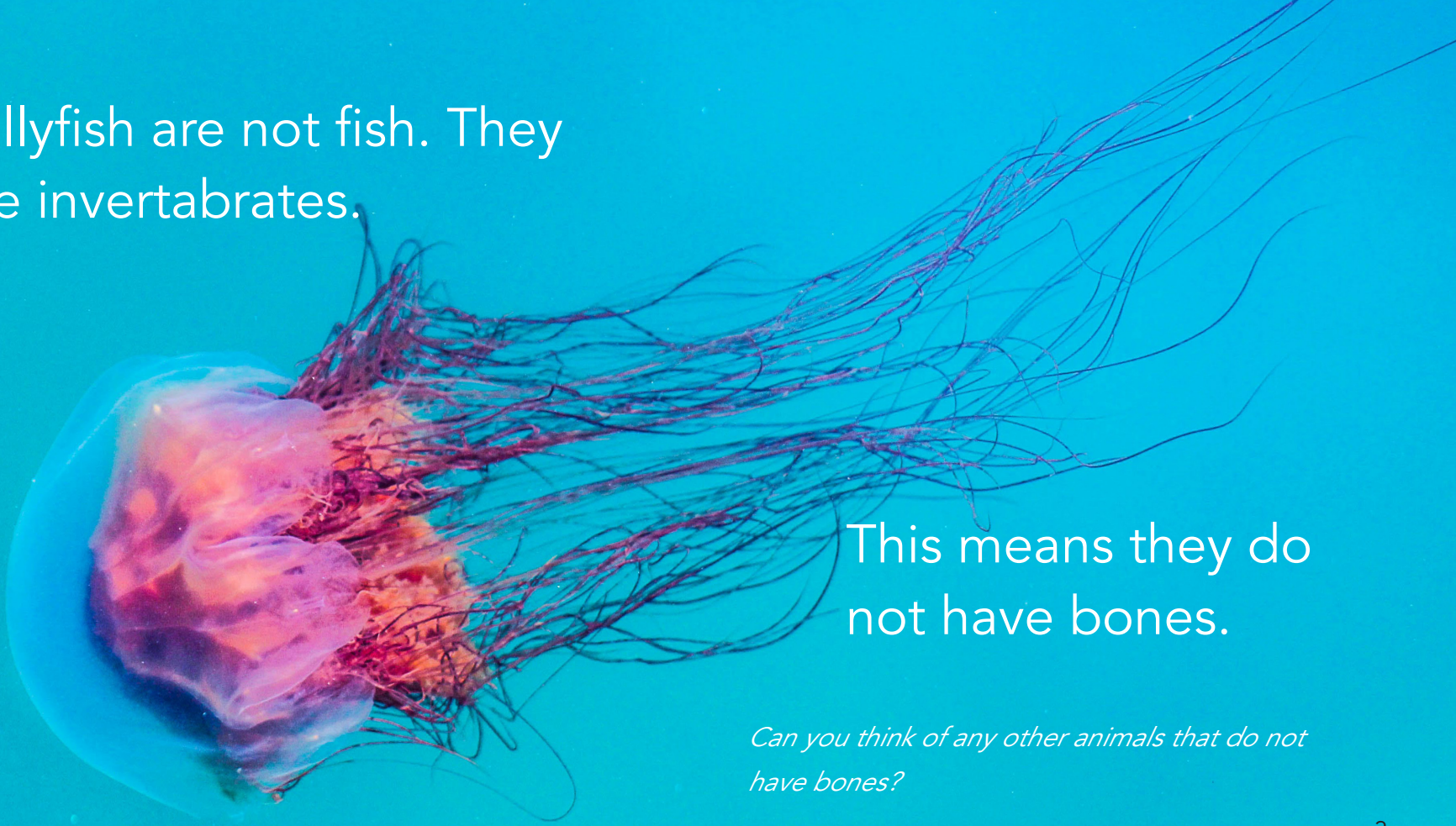

Jellyfish are not fish. They are invertebrates.




This means they do not have bones.

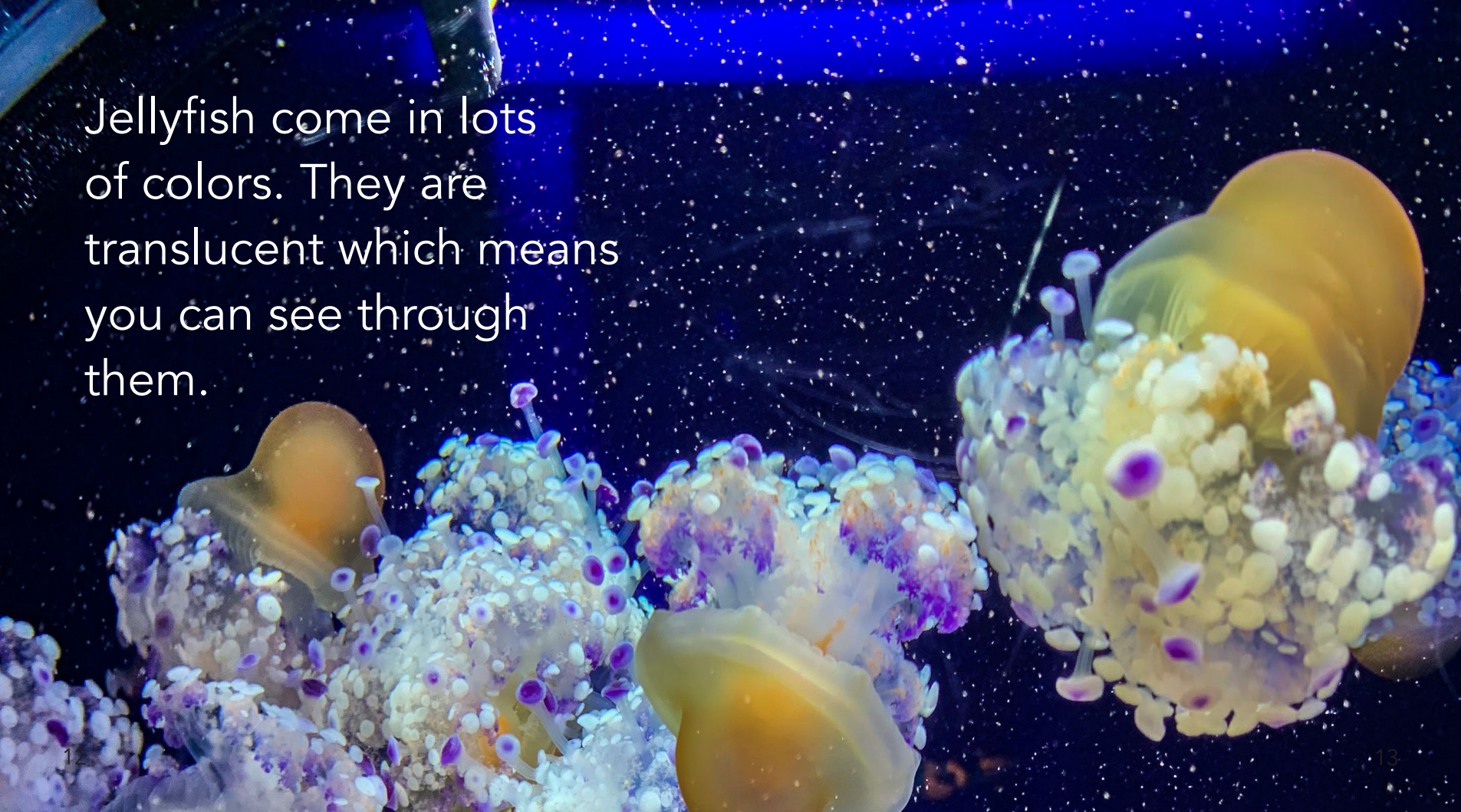
Jellyfish have long tentacles that can sting their food before they eat it. They can sting people too. Watch out!

Jellyfish are made up of mostly water.

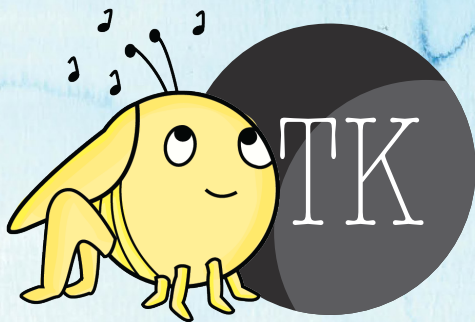


Just over half of our bodies are made of water. Wow!
