

Observe Warm Clothing Under the Microscope



We use coats to stay warm, but many animals are able to stay warm with their fur, feathers, or hair. In fact, many coats we use to keep us warm are made of natural fibers from plants or animals such as cotton or feathers. Plants and animals have amazing traits! Use Meeka microscope to observe the tiny structures that help a coat keep us warm.
