



Imran loaded up his donkey, ready to go to the village over the mountain to sell his salt.




The donkey was loved by Imran, but did not like the long trip with the heavy salt.

Imran realized what the clever donkey was doing. On the next trip, Imran loaded donkey with cotton and wool.




This time, when the donkey fell into the river, the cotton and wool soaked up a lot of water!
